


Live-in Care

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
Prevention of Hospital Admission

We design admission prevention schemes around all conditions for our clients. Close monitoring of a clients health coupled with close liaison with local based community services enables us to obtain a quick response should the client require the assistance of the Occupational Therapist , GP, Physiotherapist, District Nurse or CPN.

The primary aim of this service is to reduce the need for hospitalisation. So when you are looking at one to one care it is our expertise and experience that will notice detailed changes in our clients health.

Quick Response times mean that prevention of hospital admission is often eliminated.

We continuously risk assess our clients and have various screening tools to help reduce the risk of dehydration, falls and pressure sores to name a few.



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Hospital Discharge

Each hospital will have its own policy and arrangements for discharging patients. Normally, when you arrive in hospital the professionals in charge of your care will develop a plan for your treatment including your discharge or transfer.

The hospital discharge process can be a critical time for patients and their carers. After a period of illness they may be suffering from temporary or permanent impairment and may need assistance not previously required (including physical adaptations to their home and support services) in order to resume living at home. Discharge can thus be a point of life crisis and so needs to be handled with the full involvement of patients and professional carers.

Despite noticeable efforts in hospitals there remain a number of recurring problems that we can help with when your loved one needs assistance getting back on their feet.



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
Waking / Sleep in Nights

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COSTS AND FUNDING

A cost effective alternative to nursing home care

Angel Carers are aware of the funding issues which can arise when considering social care support. It is vital that independent financial advice is sought and we believe the earlier the better so as to ensure a fully informed decision can be made.

Families may fund their care themselves although many people are eligible to receive some support from their local authority.

Your local authority should be your first information source and can signpost you to various organisations which can assist you, your family or a representative acting on your behalf. All social care support is subject to a means test and the criteria is set annually by Parliament and an assessment of need is completed by your local authority.


We use the Fair Access to Care Criteria to band our clients. This system is set by the Department Of Health and ensures that a fair and equitable fee structure is in place.

Our Live in Care costs start from only £675 per week. Our other services are charged at the hourly rate.

OFFICE HOURS

Our office is staffed Monday to Friday 9.00am – 5.30pm. The office is open during these hours and does not close for lunch.

OUT OF HOURS

Monday to Thursday 5.30pm - 9.00 am. Friday to Monday 5.30pm - 9.00am.

The out of hours service forms our on call duty and is available to staff and clients in emergencies and where a response or guidance is required.

All emergencies are dealt with promptly by a senior member of staff.

RESPONSE TIMES
